Derek Grafton Teele - a.k.a. "Larry"

Derek went on to bigger and better things in heaven after tragically losing his life on earth in a car accident on May 4, 2007, slightly before his 18th birthday.

Derek was a typical teenage boy with a huge personality and a huge love for sports. From a very young age he always had a ball in his hand. If he couldn't be playing sports he would be going to games, watching sports on TV, writing line-ups for fantasy teams, writing out plays, or playing sport games on his Sony Play Station.

He was a very passionate person and it showed in everything he did from the way he spoke, to his every move. He was keenly aware of everything around him and was very sensitive to people's needs. Whether it was an older person struggling to walk in a parking lot, a child crying, a couple arguing in public, or an animal that strayed from home, he noticed all of it. He felt for each individual and helped out anyway he could. Turned inward, this sensitive passion caused Derek to always want to be the best at everything he did, and he was definitely his hardest critic.

Loyalty was another quality that Derek possessed. If he trusted a person or felt a connection with a teacher or subject, he was 100% dedicated to it or them. He deeply loved his family, friends, and pets. Derek did not filter any of his emotions, so everyone knew exactly where they stood with him.

His gentle soul and intense spirit were very evident in one of his favorite sayings; "I'm a lover, not a fighter, but I will fight for love!" His personal goal in life was to make people smile and his smile was radiant! So, when the sun and moon rise each day, we can be reminded of the extraordinary beauty that will always be Derek Grafton Teele.
